Children's Residence provides support and relief services for families of children who have a mental, physical or sensory disability, up to the age of 19.

The residence is staffed 24 hours a day by skilled and experienced AiMHi employees. The atmosphere resembles that of a home, including single and double bedrooms, a dining room, a large fenced yard, and ample space for play activities.

We welcome your children to stay during the following times:

- Parental relief
- Emergencies
- Holidays, except Christmas
- Period of family adjustments
- Educational reasons
- Therapeutic reasons

While staying in the Children's Residence, your child will have the opportunity to increase their independence, while making new friends.

Responsibility

AiMHi owns and operates the Residence. The Ministry of Children and Family Development requires a support service agreement to be completed before a child can be cared for at the Residence. Children registered with the At Home Program require a different agreement.

Cost

The Ministry of Children and Family Development provides the operating budget for the residence and there may be a user fee.
