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## Services

- A. To facilitate a family centered support system that is based upon the strengths and needs of the families.
- B. To assist individual family members with developing and maintaining a sense of responsibility, motivation, commitment and independence.
- C. To co-ordinate health, educational and social services within the community.
- D. To assist families in accessing community programs, i.e., leisure, education, parenting, etc.

### E. To assist families in:

- Enhance communication skills
- Promote healthy lifestyle
- Child care skills development
- Accessing community resources
- Prenatal and postnatal care
- Development of support networks
- Maintain and increase parenting skills
- Facilitating transitions and establish routines.
- Gathering and interpreting resource information
- Crisis intervention as required
- Managing behaviour
- Advocating for their families
- Self care strategies
